The Church in Antioch

¹⁹ Now those who had been scattered by the persecution that broke out when Stephen was killed travelled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus and Antioch, spreading the word only among Jews. ²⁰ Some of them, however, men from Cyprus and Cyrene, went to Antioch and began to speak to Greeks also, **telling them the good news about the Lord Jesus.** ²¹ **The Lord's hand was with them, and a great number of people believed and turned to the Lord.**

²² News of this reached the church in Jerusalem, and they sent Barnabas to Antioch. ²³ When he arrived and saw what the grace of God had done, he was glad and encouraged them all to remain true to the Lord with all their hearts. ²⁴ He was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and faith, and a great number of people were brought to the Lord. Acts 11:19-24

Perhaps you could visualise in your mind 5 people that you would like to see accepting the good news of the love and grace of our Lord. As you do so,

imagine them holding out their hands to receive His gifts. If you have any words or pictures of encouragement that you are able to share with them, please do so. If not, keep them safe somewhere, so that you can give them to them, when the time is right.

The attachment below contains a sheet for colouring in, which you are welcome to download and use for your own quiet times. As I was thinking about Grace and Thy Kingdom Come, certain elements came to mind, but how to combine them cohesively! As we have previously discovered, daffodils are the flower of Lent trumpeting in the resurrection – 3 for the arms of the cross and Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The rainbow – Grace and Hope flowing down, the sun and rays, the Light of Jesus to the world. The rest I leave to your interpretation. There are 5 figures on which you can name the chosen people that you are praying for.
