



Returning for Worship

Upon Arrival

1. Make sure you have booked a ticket for the upcoming Sunday service on Eventbrite – you don't need to print your ticket, as we'll have a register. Those who are on duty won't need to book a ticket.
2. Please enter the church via the main entrance (next to the car park) and wash your hands using the sanitiser provided.
3. A Duty Warden will meet you before you enter the main worship room to check your booking, and offer the optional Track & Trace form. The collection plate will be here too.
4. If there is a queue, please wait on the 2m markers on the floor.
5. Please begin filling rows from the end, making sure that there are at least 3 seats in between your family/bubble and the next group.

During Worship

1. Please follow any special instructions from the worship leader throughout the service, particularly during Holy Communion.
2. During August there will be no children's groups; parents/guardians are responsible for making sure children stay close to their seats.
3. Follow the signs for the toilets, making sure to adequately clean after each use.
4. Please refrain from entering the kitchen for any reason.
5. At the end of worship you will be invited to leave via the west door (at the back of church) one row at a time, starting from the back.

Other Important Information

- Although not mandatory, we strongly recommend all attendees to wear a face mask for the health and wellbeing of everyone.
- Unfortunately we won't be able to offer refreshments, so please bring a bottle of water with you.
- Please bring your own copy of the Bible!
- In order to maintain sufficient circulation, doors and windows may be opened – remember to bring a jumper if it's a cold day.

Finally, we want everyone who attends worship with us to feel safe and loved. If you need help with anything at any time, please just ask one of our Duty Wardens.
