Bangladesh is experiencing its worst floods for 20+ years, after incessant monsoon rains. Nearly half the country is under water. Water supplies polluted, homes damaged, crops destroyed. In India, flooding is affecting over 12million people, and 200 have died in Nepal from floods and landslides. This on top of Covid-19.

Covid-19 worldwide

As restrictions are reduced here, pray for countries still gripped by the disease, especially the top 3 - US, India and Brazil. In many countries, health services are ill equipped to cope.
