

Tissue paper star

You can really use any size you want, 4x4, 8x8...to make different sized stars
It takes 8 3x3 pieces to make a star. We used 4 different colours in each star,
you can use more colours or less colours. However you want to make them.

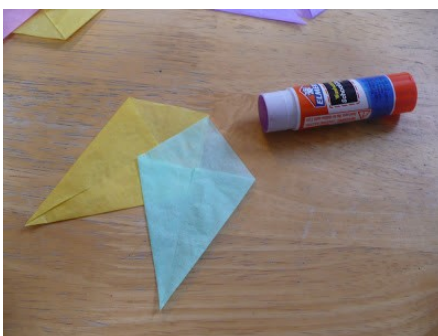


Now take your 3x3 square and fold it diagonally.

Now fold one side over so the edge lines up perfectly with the crease in the centre. I used a glue stick, and put a dab of glue down to hold it in place.



Do the same with the other side. It should look like this. Now repeat these steps with each of your 3x3 squares



Using a glue stick, we applied a small amount of glue and then lined up the next piece so the points touch and the edge of the second piece lines up perfectly with the centre fold of the first. Do this with all 8 star points. When you get back to the beginning, the very last point will tuck underneath the first. Add a little glue to hold it's place.
