Prayers

Church family & community

Give thanks for all that God has given us, especially the gift of His Son. Pray for preparations underway for Christmas, in our church and the others in Woodley. Pray for the RE Inspired Team, as they present Jesus in schools. Also for the Foodbank team, assisting poorer families in Woodley. Pray for the sick, especially Mike, Sue, Eoin, Fiona & others we know.

National

Pray for Rishi Sunak and his Govt after the re-shuffle - for wisdom in tackling inflation, immigration & hospital waiting lists. Pray for Christians in politics - in national and local Govt - as they promote Christian values & standards. Pray for the outworking of recent decisions by the C of E General Synod and for unity in the Church.

Mission Links

Pray for the Fletcher family, spending the year in UK, but returning to Thailand in July 2024. The Rays are adjusting to life in Arusha, with the young NGO SAFi, whilst the Adams have taken over leadership at Neema. Pray for the team at Kimbilio DRC, and for Ian Harvey in UK; pray for funds for the new Day Care Centre. Wider World

Israel and Palestine. Praise God for the recent 6 day pause in hostilities in Gaza and the release of both hostages and Palestinian prisoners. Pray for restraint on both sides in new fighting, for a new truce and more releases. Pray that more medical aid, food and water will enter Gaza. Pray for a long term peace solution, and that conflict will not escalate.

Nepal Earthquake. A powerful earthquake hit remote western areas last month, killing 160 people and damaging 62,000 homes. Nearly 900 schools were hit and 150,000 people still require relief goods, especially for water and sanitation. Pray for them.

COP 28 Climate Conference. Pray for delegates & climate activists in Dubai, 30 Nov-12 Dec. for bold targets to reduce fossil fuel use and real outcomes, not empty promises for a fair & just "loss & damage fund" to help countries most hit by climate change that the voice of suffering communities will be heard above the oil companies for families who have lost farmland, animals, livelihoods & fresh-water because of extreme weather and have run out of adapting options

for the polluters - for change of heart and practice, putting planet before profit for renewed commitment to 1.5-2.0deg temperature target & actions to match

World Peace.

Pray for peace in other conflict areas, especially in Ukraine, Sudan, Syria and Yemen. Pray for Christian churches in these places.
