## **Church family & community**

Pray for the many activities at St James, especially Pre-School, Mum's and Toddlers and Cafe. Pray for families in need around Woodley and the work of Foodbank. #### **National**

#### Wider World.

#### Gaza

As the Israel-Hamas conflict continues, over 25,000 Palestinians have been killed, many more injured. Few medical facilities are running; water and food are scarce. Pray for the suffering population, especially children. Pray for peace, for more crossing points for aid and for safety of aid workers; pray for the Church in the Middle East.

## **Bangladesh**

A serious fire recently ripped through a Rohingya refugee camp in SE Bangladesh, rendering 900 families (about 5,000 people) homeless. Pray for Tearfund partners responding to their needs and for long-term hope for the Rohingya people.

#### Yemen

Pray for an easing of tensions in the Red Sea, as Houthi militias target cargo ships. Pray for civilian population of Yemen after nearly 10 years of civil war; around 22 million people are displaced and/or short of food, with very few basic services.

#### **Crises in Africa**

Mozambique, Zimbabwe, Malawi and Zambia are badly hit by a resurgence of Covid-19, coupled with cholera outbreak; in Zambia alone, 500 have died. The civil war in Sudan continues, displacing 6m. people. After a month of heavy rain in DRC, the Congo River is at a 60yr high, destroying thousands of homes; 300 lives lost.
