Wider World.

Middle East

Pray for an end to the terrible situation in Gaza, and for a cease-fire. Around 1.1m children are facing hunger and disease, and the saf(er) haven of Raffa city is under threat. Pray for hostage release, for peace and wider delivery of food, water and medical supplies. Pray too for de-escalation of tensions in the Red Sea & Yemen.

S.Sudan. The country has struggled with internal conflict, floods and disease - but now made worse by arrival of over half a million refugees fleeing conflict in N.Sudan. Pray for people in over-crowded camps, for increased flow of aid and for peace in Sudan.

Philippines. One of the world's most disaster-prone countries, a southern province recently suffered a massive landslide which claimed 15 lives and 100 more missing; 31 people were rescued. A 5.6 earthquake followed shortly afterwards. Pray for the survivors and for communities in need of food, water and shelter.

Climate Change. Over the last year, global temperatures have increased beyond the 1.5 deg. thresh-hold, above which the world faces severe & irreversible consequences. Pray for more action from Govts worldwide to cut carbon emissions, embrace renewables and protect forests; pray for poor communities most affected.
