

Middle East

Pray that the conflict between Israel & Iran will not further escalate.

Madagascar. Parts of this island, off the E. coast of Africa, have been hit by Cyclone Gamane, impacting over 0.5 million people and causing widespread destruction. Pray for affected communities. In the south of mainland Africa - Zambia, Mozambique and Malawi farmers are struggling with the worst drought for years; Climate Change is disrupting weather patterns.

Ukraine and Sudan

Pray for an end to these 2 devastating conflicts. Last month saw 57 children killed or injured by Russian attacks. In Sudan, civil war has raged for 1 year, with 6 million internally displaced people and 18m acutely short of food. Pray for peace.
