Following the consultation evening at the end of June, the Building Committee sought approximate costings for the plans that had been drawn up for a new building on our site. The figure quoted by our architect was very high, and the PCC have concluded that these plans are simply too expensive for what we might reasonably be able to raise. We will now be taking a period for prayer and reassessment, and draw up some new plans after the summer. Some essential surveys of our site will be conducted in the meantime. We trust that God is steering us through this process - please continue to pray that His will is done, and that the work of St James' will thrive whatever comes.
